Confirming Student Completion of Learning for a Lesson


In the last five minutes of every lesson, students will be required to answer the question "What have I learnt in today's lesson" in the comment box at the bottom of the lesson post.

This will be for the following purpose:


- The teacher will know that the student has been engaged in the learning for the lesson

Note: comments posted this way will be seen by the whole class


Step 1 – Go to the class that you plan to work on




Step 2 – in the *Stream* section of the page, locate the lesson that you will be working on today
