
Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Program

Minimum Device Specifications and Requirements







Devices & Operating Systems

- Chromebook Latest Chrome OS version
- Windows Laptop Windows 10 or Windows 11
- Apple Laptop MacOS 12 or newer

Android, iPhone, iPad, and Linux devices are **not** supported at the school.



Internet Browser

• Google Chrome

This is automatically installed on Chromebooks but it is requested if your child has a Windows or Apple laptop that you install Google Chrome onto the device before bringing it in to be connected to the network.



RAM and Storage

- Chromebook 32GB Storage and 4GB RAM
- Windows & Apple Laptop 128GB Solid State Storage and 8GB RAM



Screen Size

Minimum: 11"



Battery Life

 A minimum of 8 hours battery life is required so that the device lasts the whole school day.



Wireless Connectivity

Devices <u>must</u> support the following:

- 5GHz 802.11n or 802.11ac or 802.11ax standard
- WPA2 Enterprise security

Devices with only 2.4ghz support will not be compatible with the school's WiFi network and <u>not</u> allow connectivity. Please ask the vendor if the device is 5ghz compatible or contact the school for advice.



Keyboard

• The device MUST have a physical keyboard.

Additional Considerations

- A case/cover to protect the device from drops
- A lightweight device to make it easier to carry
- Insurance in the event the device is broken or lost
- Extended warranty to reduce future possible repair costs
- Computer life expectancy is 4 years (not including physical damage/wear and tear). Meaning that students entering Year 7 may require a new device entering senior years.
